THURSDAY OBSERVANCES IN BCS
CHRIST WAS CRUCIFIED ON
THURSDAY NOT FRIDAY.

The essence of Thursday 6 to 6 fasting in BCS is to commemorate His suffering and passions on that fateful day. The 3 hourly watch spotlight His period of agony to the grave for the salvation of man.

Our Lord was arrested at 3 a.m., condemned to death at 6 a.m., crucified on the cross at 9 a.m. His body was on Cross from that time 3 p.m. and finally brought down at 6 p.m.

TEXTS: 6 a.m. - Matt. 27: 1 - 44; Confession of sins, prayer for the world. 9.00 a.m. Mk. 15: 1-32; 12 brethren pray. 12 noon - John 19: 1 - 37; 3 p.m. Luke 23: 1-49. At about 5.45 - General confession two by two. 6.00 p.m. Luke 23: 50 - end. Each reading is followed by the song "Father forgive us ... and songs by choirs and prayers.

Other intervals are covered by testimonies, visions, choruses etc. Closing is same with other services after sermon by the Conductor.

Bible Class is a special teachings of the Supernatural Teacher of the Universe, Leader O. O. Obu to His Children whereby the secret doctrine of the Kingdom is revealed and expounded with corresponding Bible Witnesses. ORDER OF CHILD BLESSING

This usually takes place after brief morning prayer.

1. Parents and other relations of the child kneel before the Altar while a sister carries the Child.
2. 1st Bible Lesson: Luke 2:22 is read by a member.
3. Anthems by the Choir(s)
4. Prayer by 2 Sisters and 2 brothers.
5. The Conductor descends from the Altar.
6. Hymn 427 or 50 or 51 etc. (from (BHB) is sang continuously (all kneeling).
7. The child is presented to the Conductor who places him/her on the Altar turning the child each time onto the four corners of the world with silent words of sanctification.
8. The Condcutor sprinkles Holy Oil on the forehead, robs same on both hands and legs and making sign of Cross on the forehead and back. The child is given Holy water to drink

9. The child is lifted up, bow three times before the Pulpit, and hand over to the Sister.
10. The Conductor moves back to the Pulpit.
11. 2nd Bible Lesson: Eph. 6: 1-4.
12. Golden Text: 1 Tim. 2: 15.
13. Brief admonition by the Conductor.
14. 1st. Spiritual song: "Eyen Eron Uwa (3times) amana in fin emi." Members of the family get back to their seat by dancing past the altar.
15. 2nd Spiritual song: Eyen amana ono nyin (2times), Ekom Edidem Ubon Ekondo, Eyen amana ono nyin" The entire congregation thank the Father by dancing past the Altar.
16. Love feast.
17. Testimony from the parents of the child.
18. Closing. (the blessed child and family are escorted to their home whereby the house is sanctified).

SHORT SERVICE AT THE CEMETRY

1. Hymn.
2. Prayer by the Conductor.
3. Prayer by a member.
4. Silent prayer (Special prayer to be read by the Conductor during the silent prayer). Thus:

Most sweet Jesus, Redeemer of human race. Look down upon us, humble prostrate before Thine Altar. We are Thine and Thine we wish to be but to be more surely united with Thee. Behold each one of us freely consecrates himself to Thy Most Sacred Heart. Many indeed have never known Thee. Many too despising Thy precepts have rejected Thee. Have mercy on them all most merciful Jesus and draw them to Thy Sacred Heart.

Be Thou King O Lord not only of the faithful who have never forsaken Thee, but also of the prodigal children who have abandoned Thee. Grant that they die may quickly return to their Father's house lest they die of wretchedness and hunger. Be Thou King of all those who are deceived by erroneous opinions or whom discord keeps aloof and call them back to the harbour of truth and unity of faith so that soon they may be one flock and one Shepherd. Be Thou King of all those who are still involved in darkness of idolatry and Islamism. And refuse not to draw them back to the light and Kingdom of God.

Turn Thy eyes of mercy towards the children of that race once Thy chosen people. Of old they called down upon themselves the blood of the Saviour. May it now descend upon upon them a lover of redemption and of life. Grant O Lord to Thine Church, assurance of freedom

immunity from harm. Give peace from pole to pole with one cry: Praise; to the Divine Heart that wrought our salvation. To it be glory and honour for ever and ever, Amen.

7. Psalm 23; The Lord's Prayer, Benediction.

8. Interment - Reading of "Dust to Dust" by the Conductor.

For as much as it has pleased the Almighty God of his great mercy to take unto Himself the soul of our beloved Brother/Sister here departed, we therefore commit his/her body to the ground, earth to earth, ash to ash, dust to dust, being sure and hopeful of resurrection to eternal life through our Lord Jesus Christ, Amen.

9. Spiritual Choruses suitable for the occasion until the grave is completely filled with earth.

10. Prayer for the deceased and his/her relations.

11. Closing.

NOTE: After burial, the deceased family should be visited from time to time and charitable offers render for up-keep.

2. Song(s) by the Choir(s).
Members of the bereaved family kneel before the Altar.
3. Prayer - two Sisters and two Brothers. (All prayers should be entirely for the safety of the family).
4. Lessons: Rev. 14: 13; Heb. 4: 10 -12; 1st Thes. 4: 13 -18.
A brief advice to the family by the Conductor.
5. Spiritual song: "Hallelujah joy x(2) etc. The family and the relations who knelt down before the Altar get back to their seats. Everybody dancing and praising the Father.
6. Closing hymn.
7. Members of the bereaved family are escorted home. Freewill donation is conducted and the money derived is handed over to the bereaved family.
8. Prayer.
9. Closing.

ORDER OF MARRIAGE BLESSING

Marriage Blessing in Brotherhood of the Cross & Star has a far-reaching effect on couples spiritually than any other place solemnized either in the court or in other churches.

Such an occasion is always preceded by a full service (see Sunday Service conduction).

ORDER OF CONDUCTING PART (II)

- . Bride and Bridegroom and other relations sit before the Altar.
- . Bible Reading: Matt. 19: 4 - 9.
- . Special Anthems by the Choir(s) present (during which the conductor offers silent prayer over the couple).
- . Prayer by four (4) members.
- . Washing the couple's feet and anointment, while the Congregation sings the song (Amayom ndisanga ye Ami, suhore idem ...)
- . At the end of anointment, the Spiritual Songs for blessing the couple continue: "Akamba Doctor" "Akwa Etubom Ekong"
- . Prayer by the Officiating Brother.
- . The Bride's Prayer

while Choir continue to sing
until the Sacrament is over.
