FIRST LESSON: ACTS 3:24-25:

Yea, and all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days. Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, and in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.

SECOND LESSON: 1 JOHN 4:19-21:

We love him, because he first loved us. If a man say, I love God, and hated his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment have we from him, that he who loveth God love his brother also.

GOLDEN TEXT: ROMANS 8:29-31:

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover, whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us; who can be against us?

SPIRITUAL CHORUS:

"IF GOD BE FOR US WHO CAN BE AGAINST US".



THE WISDOM OF GOD CONFOUNDS MAN:

That is what we have for you, man can never be like God, neither can God be like man. When God makes his covenant, it must stand for eternity, what He has chosen can not be destroyed, His covenant can not be changed. That is why you are now witnessing the fulfillment of the belief that some people constitute impediments to those who want to gain entry into the kingdom although they themselves have no desire to go in. This is why the wealthy, healthy, intellectuals, prominent ones are not found here in the kingdom but only the insignificant ones, down trodden in the society are the ones, He has called into the kingdom of God. What the father has chosen has been chosen for eternity; for this reason the people of the world question this. This goes to show that the wisdom of God confounds man.

Re-examine the First Lesson.

FIRST LESSON: ACTS 3:24-25

Yea, and all the prophets from samuel and those that follow after, as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days. Ye are the children of the prophets, and of the covenant which God made with our fathers, saying unto Abraham, and in thy seed shall all the kindreds of the earth be blessed.

THE CHILDREN OF THE NEW COVENANT:

This is a lucky generation. Has God forgotten His covenant made with us? But you on your part have forgotten the covenant God made with you. For that reason you lament that you have no wealth or God had not chosen you for any righteous deed or your attainment but because of the covenant He made with our father, Abraham. Should you take a critical look at Brotherhood you would discover that a lot of those ordained as the Apostles, prophets, prophetess, elders etc., have refused to perform their various works

as stipulated and on being questioned they will not be able to give tangible reasons why this is so. What they say is that they are fed up with the situation of things. However, God is the same because God would never forget the covenant He made with our father, Abraham. Consequently, He still performs the rite of ordination. What ever God has chosen has been chosen for eternity.

SPIRITUAL CHORUS:

***"WHAT HAD BEEN CHOSEN IS THUS CHOSEN
AND I HAVE NO REGRETS FOR DOING SO."***



Most of us here are not chosen because of our good works, some people maintain that should our names be removed from Brotherhood, we would attend other churches like Apostolic, Roman Catholic, etc. this is not true for what has been chosen by God stands for eternity. I have chosen you and even if your name is removed from the register here what about the heavenly one. God does not make a mistake in His decision.

If you watch this all-ordained ones' meeting with the Holy Father which is today, you would observe that only two or three persons are present. All they do is stay back from the meeting. Some are given to evil words, thus you will see no one here, they indulge in those things one is not suppose to do. God has no regrets, for what is happening is in accordance with the covenant He made with Abraham. We are not being joyful because the call is extended to us but because God has remembered His covenant with us in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. *Re-examine the second lesson.*

SECOND LESSON: JOHN 4: 19 - 21

We love him, because he first loved us. If a man say, I love God, and hated his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom^m he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen?

And this commandment have we from him, that he who loveth God love his brother also.

SPIRITUAL CHORUS:

"DO YOU LOVE JESUS, YES BECAUSE HE FIRST LOVED ME. BROTHER, DO YOU LOVE JESUS, YES BECAUSE HE FIRST LOVED ME. BROTHERHOOD, DO YOU LOVE JESUS, YES, HE FIRST LOVED ME. OH PROPHET, DO YOU LOVE JESUS, YES, HE FIRST LOVED ME. OH BRETHREN, DO YOU LOVE JESUS, YES HE FIRST LOVED ME".

HE WHO LOVES GOD LOVES HIS BROTHER:

All that is done here is likened to you being a debtor and your creditor asks you to defray the debts by paying it to others. We are unable for eternity to pay this debt owed Christ because He first loved us. He gave us life, and has taken all things in His kingdom and given same to us.

We are indebted to Christ in the sense that He has loved us and we must reciprocate His love for us. Christ loves us not because of what we have done, failed to do, or whom we are but because of the covenant God made with Abraham that his seed shall be His chosen ones because He will be the father of all nations and we are his descendants.

I am thankful to God immensely because if it was by the power of man a lot of us here would have been driven away, right from when you were ordained as a pastor, prophets, etc., you have been unable to practice the Word of God, and have been lukewarm towards the things pertaining to God. You have become a degenerate to the extent that you now insult God and indulge in things not glorifying to God. Whatever you do is meaningless, even if you put your turban in fire just because you do not want to identify with God is insignificant. God has no regrets in ordaining or choosing you as His elect according to the covenant He made with Abraham. That is why when you are sick, He heals you, when you are in trouble, He comes to your aid. He has salvaged you and the whole of your household in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

THE UNSHAKEN LOVE:

So when someone claims to love God but hates his brother, he is a liar because if you do not love your brother whom you see how would you love God. Therefore, he who loves God must love his brother. Those of us called into the kingdom had we done the work assigned to us, the whole world would have trooped down here and affirmed that we are the children of God.

Out of the abundance of the heart, the mouth speaketh and by confession man is saved. All of you here should you reveal His glory, practise the Word of God, impute no sins to others, not belittle others, prepare charms, fornicate, steal etc. you would have been said to have fulfilled the Word of God.

This shows the love God has for us. Whether you came here or not what had been written must come to pass even as it has been written that you have been chosen and your name is written in the Book of Life, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Had as many as are being called and selected come here, this place would not have accommodated everyone. But because the ways of God are not man's, God does His things the way it pleases Him. He had already chosen us and has done so for eternity.

Re-examine the Golden Text:

GOLDEN TEXT: ROMANS 8:29-31

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified, and whom he justified, them he also glorified. What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

THOSE CALLED ARE JUSTIFIED:

The love of God towards man is greater than anything in the whole world. He has overcome everything in the entire world. Those who are rich, noble, wise, prudent, the knowledged and prominent are in quest for this glory, but He has not given to them. Accordingly He has given it to us the down-trodden in the society. Unfortunately though he has chosen us we have continued to speak slanderous words against Him. However He has not deprived us of this ordination because of His love for us.

First Witness: Romans 9:14-16.

Therefore, brethren we would not be tedious with you. He who has ears to hear, let him hear. May God bless His holy words - Amen.
