acceptable to God. Whatever a child does or whatever is the out-come of a child's life is what he/she has copied from the parents. Parents are the sample copies of their children.

Truth, kindness, patience, humility, meekness, etc, should be the base on which to rear them to good expectation. Using fool and abusive languages on our children should be avoided for the little children are the greatest in the sight of Jehovah God and His Christ.

THE CHILDREN'S CREED

Children, obey your parents in the Lord for this right.

WHAT THE CHILDREN SHOULD KNOW

CORRECT READING AND PRAYING:

They should Read both English and Vernacular Bibles. Start and end prayers.

To pray; first close your eyes, and place two palms together before you begin thus:

"Let thanks and praise be to the Father in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ - Amen.

Let thanks and praise be to the Pather, now and forever more - Amen.

Holy, Holy. Conclude as you started, using the same words.

Begin to narrate a testimoney/Dream/Vision thus:

In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, In the blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, Now and forever more, Amen

This is my testimony on the work of Holy Spirit - Conclude as you started, using the same words.

Begin to confess sins thus: In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ In the blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, Yow and forever more, Amen This is to confess my sins before God and His Witnesses and to pray for His forgiveness Conclude as you started, using the same words.

SING CORRECTLY:

Sabbath Choirs must be able to sing the correct version of the following as contained in our Sure Foundation Hymnary Introit, Doxologies, Vesper Songs, Child Blessing Songs and the Lord's Prayer.

Since Brotherhood has a peculiar pattern of doing everything, to avoid confusion, all Sabbath Teachers/Choirmaster who are not conversant with tonic solfa notations should please, contact the students' Choirmaster-General for details and information.

We have now started organizing a seperate singing exercise for Sabbath Group of Choirs. This in fact, has stimulated keen desire to compete amongst themselves and pave ways for improved standard of performance.

MORAL INSTRUCTIONS:

Many children are fond of either shaking or nodding their heads when answering questions. They are to be taught the correct way to answer questions through this simple expression: Yes Brother or No Sister.

EXAMPLE:

Question, "Mary, did you attend Sabbath Lesson yesterday"

Answer: Mary: "No Brother/No Sister, I was not well to be able to attend Sabbath Lesson yesterday".

They must not be allowed to fight or insult each other. They must be told that it is good to obtain permission whenever one wants to go out for anything or to ease one's self.

Noise-making during services and after Classes must be discouraged by all means.

Children Sabbath is held on every Saturday by 2.00p.m Sabbath Choir practices are held every Wednesday. First Saturday of every month is set aside for all Area Sabbath Children meeting in their respective Headquarters by 10.00a.m for spiritual revival.

Parents are requested to help the children financially to enable them carry out their assignments successfully. Teachers should educate the children to know those portions which follow them. For feasts on other days except on Wednesdays, read John 6:51 -

1st Cor. 10:16-17, Sing Hymn 201 (Sure Foundation Hymnary). For feast on Wednesday sing only Hymn 202 (Sure Foundation Hymnary).

Reciting the Lord's Prayer, Psalm 1,15, and 121, should be emphasized.

Teachers should always encourage the children to take active part in conducting their services and songs, Teachers are only to watch, direct, and give necessary corrections when the children go wrong

FACTS YOU MUST NEVER FORGET:

- 1. The Registration of Sabbath Children in the Bethels.
- 2. Age of Registration: One day until when the child ceases to act and hehave as a child.
- 3. Registration Fee of 50K per child
- 4. Weekly dues of 10K per child; i.e 50K per month.
- 5. Sabbath Meetings day: Every Saturday by 2.00p.m.
- 6. Every 1st Saturday of the month: Children's Area General Meeting by 10.00am with fasting 6.00am to 12 noon.

- 7. Every 5th Friday of the month: Children's Area Fund Raising Function.
- 8. Feast Money: One Naira (#1.00) per child to be collected before the commencement of every Pentecostal and forwarded to the Headquarters.
- 9. Nominal Roll Registration of №1.00 per child.
- 10. Sabbath Bethels termly dues: Five Naira (\$5.00) to the Headquarters.
- 11. No football, flag etc. should be introduced to the children.
- 12. Every child should have his/her Membership Card.

PROPOSALS FOR 1991:

The Executive of the Children Fellowship has come up with some proposals for the year 1991

THEY ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- (a) Children 4th Pilgrimage to Biakpan: 9th to 10th February, 1991.
- (b) Compilation of Nominal Roll-Volume Four
- (c) Prizes during August Anniversary

- (d) Ministry work within Nigeria and Abroad.
- (e) Seminar for the Sabbath Teachers.

Now let us look into these points sequentially

THE FOURTH PILGRIMAGE TO BIAKPAN IS SCHEDULED FOR FEBRUARY, 9TH - 10TH:

All children in the whole Brotherhood World are to be there. The Ceremony will feature Drama, sing song Night, Presentation of gifts, outing, visiting of the Chiefs/Elders etc., of Biakpan City.

The Theme of the Children 's Pilgrimage to Biakpan is "In Appreciation to the Holy Father's Youthful Manifestations" The Wonders He performed at the ages of eight days, three and five years.

(b) NOMINAL ROLL COMPILATION:

All Sabbath Children in Brotherhood World are involved in this exercise, ranging from a day old child to as long as the child remains young in thought, action and behaviour. The exercise is being introduced by the Father Himself. A circular to this effect had been sent out to all Bethels of Brotherhood of the Cross and Star.

Enrolment is made with only (#1.00) or its equivalent outside Nigeria. The names are to be compiled Bethel by Bethel and passed through the Leader's Representative of the Area for proper checking and onward sub-mission to the Headquarters Treasury. Each Volume of a Nominal-Roll is to be published during every August Pentecostal Assembly. This will enable a child maintain his/her international number in the children Fellowship Card, (Baptizmal Certificate Card, child blessing card and later, the adult international membership cards).

Note that these four cards are all International Cards, within the International Registers which are before the Father.

Secondly wherever a child travels to, within or outside the country, his/her number on the register will be demanded of him/her. The compilation process will remain continuous.

(d) GIVING PRIZES TO THE BEST GROUP OF CHILDREN/CHOIR OR INDIVIDUAL

It will be recalled that in the past years when the children were not having singing exercises of their own, prizes were made to the best performances either in solo/duet or recitation. Scholarships were also awarded to few brilliant children during their day with the Holy Father. The executive of the Children Fellowship has decided to revive and restore those benefits in addition to the prizes won during singing exercises (only during the August Pentecostal). Sabbath

Teachers/Parents are hereby warned not to deprive their children of these priviledges given them. They should see to it that the children they bring to the headquarters are well trained so as to benefit from these gifts from the Father.

(e) MINISTRY WORK:

Ministry work or Evangelical Missionary Trips is one of the Holy Sacraments in Brotherhood of the Cross and Star, which the children are not exempted from participating.

Every member in Brotherhood of the Cross and Star can easily testify of going from house to house, village to village, Country to Country Ministering for the Father. They always come back with marvellous testimonies. If old men and women who cannot walk for a long distance nor can they bend down easily, nor withstand the heat or cold of any country do come back with inspiring testimonies before the Holy Father, then what do you expect from the little children who are both spiritually and physically wit and flexible. The answer is that they will do much more, better than the older people. Let us now arise, help to bring up these little ones, and send them out on Oversea Ministry work. Remember our Lord saying: "Suffer the little children to come unto me, forbid them not, for of such is the Kingdom of Heaven.

Children have a very big role to play in Ministering for the Lord. Older men are warned for their own interest, not to stop their children from serving the Father; for the Father wants to use them to disgrace the mighties of the world.

BROTHERHOOD OF THE CORSS AND STAR GUIDELINES TO SYLLABUS FOR LESSONS IN THE BROTHERHOOD CHILDREN SABBATH MEETINGS

WEEK ONE: FIRST TERM

The Birth of the Leader of the Universe (Leader Olumba Olumba Obu).

- (a) Bible Record about Him
- (b) The Ruler will be born of a woman Revelation 12:15 (As delivered by the Father).

QUOTE:

"Does this not prove to you that the person who would rule the world with a rod would be brought forth by a woman and would not come from the ground or out of the wind, but will be born of a woman. The woman may take any form with any colour of the skin. She may be black or white, but certainly the channel would be a woman. I think most of you are gazing into the sky: Look now on the ground He has come down".

DISMISS YOUR NEGATIVE IDEA:

You are now charged to dismiss your negative thoughts that a person will descond from the sky to rule over all nations with an iron rod".

GET the message straight. It is not that He would rule over trees, or beasts, or blacks, or whites. Rather, He will rule over all nations. Do you think that this is something to joke about?

What worries human understanding is that this child, who is to rule all nations with an iron rod, is to be brought forth by a woman and there after caught up unto God. He stays with God on His throne. So brethren, if we should examine these prophesies carefully, we would see that they have been fulfilled.

THE ROD OF IRON:

Signifies that He comes to occupy the Royal Throne. He does not come like our Lord Jesus Christ to preach from place to place He has come as the King of Kings. The Rod of Iron is part of the regalia of His Kingship. He has come to rule over things created and uncreated. He has come to assume His Glory. That is the significance of the Rod of Iron. All Angels, men and things bow down to Him. Anyone who does not accept His reign, will be eliminated at His command. His only duty is to give orders. He goes to nowhere what so ever!

WEEK TWO: - MORE PROPHESIES:

Prophetess Otom Egan Otim Osim of Biakpan, had prophesied a bout the birth of the Leader. In her prophesy, she was led to instruct the people that they were to be punished for seven (7) years as a result of

disobedience to the instructions of God. After six (6) years of suffering the people pleaded with the Prophetess to pray and ask her God to forgive them. She was again led to reveal to them that the seventh year should be used for self santification in readiness to moving into the promised land Biakpan, where the son of Man would be born to the family of Olumba.

HIS BIRTH:

The Sole Spiritual Head Leader Olumba Olumba Obu was born in the little Town of Biakpan in the year 1918. It was the year, the first world war ended. The great influenza of that year affected all regions around Biakpan and claimed many lives. This compared much with the time when Christ was born and King Herod ordered the killing of children below the age of two years.

WEEK THREE: THE HOLY FATHER'S ADVICE
TO CHILDREN

CHOICE OF THE FOOLISH AND WEAK TO DISGRACE THE WISE AND STRONG:

TEXT: - 1 Corinthians 1:27

But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God had chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty.

GOD'S REGARDS FOR CHILDREN:

The Father said, 'Generally, the children were not regarded, but God places much importance on the children. So children

chose to spend their time playing, thinking that they can do no more. Parents and Elders also feel that children can do nothing reasonable, and dismiss them merely as playful lots. Everyone should know that God uses children to do wonderful things.

God used children like Samuel, Jonathan and David. They were small when God started using them.

The Isrealites wanted a King to lead them against the Philistines. Samuel the prophet, searched for a King for a long time but could not find one.

SAUL AS A YOUTH CHOSEN KING: (I Samuel 9:15-27: 10:1-16

Saul and his brethren were searching for their father's lost sheep for three days without any luck. They decided to consult a seer who could help them. This decision was taken, on the advice of one of his father's servants.

They went to Prophet Samuel, who entertained. Samuel said to Saul that he was to be King of the Isrealites. He also told Saul that the sheep they were looking for had been found. Saul was the least among his brethren.

WEEK FOUR: LITTLE DAVID ANNOINTED KING OF ISREAL:

(I Samuel 16:1-13)
Prophet Samuel, at a later date was sent by God to the house of Jesse to annoint a King

because a Saviour was to come from there.

The Spirit did not choose any of Jesse's seven big sons. It was when David, the least of Jesse's sons was brought from the field where he tended the sheep, that Samuel became possed with the Holy Spirit; and was directed to arise and annoint little David. He proclaimed David King of the Isreelites.

WEEK FIVE: THE CHILD DEVID DEFEATED GOLIATH

(I Samuel 17:31-51)

David was only a child when he defeated Goliath. God uses the weak to disgrace the strong. Therefore, children should never regard themselves as worthless beings. Rather, they should pray for their parents when they are ill. They should pray for their Elders when on Ministry Services.

WEEK SIX: FEELING OF SPIRITUAL GREATNESS:

Children should not look down on themselves as being poor or orphans. God loves them more than the highly placed and mighty people. He wants them more than he wants the adults. For this reason, the children have Saturdays for their Services. A day is also kept for their Fellowship Meetings.

A time would come when people from Overseas would come to share in the blessings of the children Fellowship Day. God uses all

children for wonderful works; as such, you must start at this early age to reverence and serve God. God wants and loves all of you.

The Father continued, "I want boys and girls who are virgins to come up and serve God. There are scholarships for the virgins, Offices are reserved for virgins the Vineyard is big but the workers are few.

"How I wish you children knew the place I have reserved for you. Your parents should not be said or jealous of where I have kept for you. They should rejoice for, when the children can accomplish what the parents could not, the parents would be blessed for the children's sake.

The Father said He was very happy to see the adults participating in the children Fellowship Meeting. He assured them of lots of testimonies.

WEEK SEVEN: YOU REAP WHAT YOU SOW

Galatiens 6:10

Anything you sow is what you will reap. If you sow corruption, you reap corruption. If you were a dis-respectful child during your youth, your children will be disrespectful too. If you are a deceiver, you will meet deceivers, and will be deceived by other too. If you are a gossiper, your children will inherit your gossiping habit.

Many children lament that they are not well-cared for. They are not worthy to be cared for because they fail to carry out the instructions of God and they have no love of God in them. If you are able to carry out the instructions and teachings of our Lord Jesus Christ you will have no problems in life.

You grumble within your heart that if you lived during the time of Adam, Melchisedek, Jesus and other holy ones, you could have worshipped and kept to God's commandments.

What are you doing today in this New-Kingdom of God established now on earth after your long prayer of; May your Kingdom Come.

This is the best generation which Adam, Melchizedek and the rest wanted and waited for. If you have the love and practise the gospel of this New Kingdom, you will be glad within yourself. If you are opportuned to read the book of the great "I AM THAT I AM, you will know that the word of God does not wait until you grow up and own cars, or acquire wealth before you start to practise it. I started when I was only three years old. The children we see will grow up to correct the bad behaviours of the adults.

WEEK EIGHT: PURITY IS THE KEY TO YOUR SUCCESS

(I Timothy 4:12; II Tim. 2:22; I John 3)
The children of God are born to remain
God's children while the children of the

flesh also born as fleshly people.

The children of God do not fornicate nor commit adultry. They do not commit any act of sin. They are clean.

This Kingdom is of God and is full of joy. My little children, waht is disturbing you in serving God? Go to School and become well educated, then you come and serve or work for God.

It would not be long, I will send you to Overseas Countries like Japan, America, etc., to work for God since you are the children of God. We have three books for this Fellowship. They are:-

- i) BROTHERHOOD OF MAN
- ii) FLEE FORNICATION
- iii) SUBMIT TO YOUR ELDERS

These books are not for you alone, but for the entire world. They are to be used in teaching the word of God to people; to enable them know what is obtained in this fold.

If you want to marry, do so with one husband and have children but still serve God. This Kingdom does not want fornicators, liars and other vices.

The Father wants virgins. This is a new generation, and virgins must come out from your Fellowship.

WEEK NINE: CHILDREN CAN PERFORM WONDERFULLY WELL

Our Lord Jesus Christ had said, Allow the little children to come unto me, for theirs is the Kingdom of God. He who receives the little children, receives Me. The children will go on Ministry Work Overseas. Christ student Mary in Liverpool is performing wonderful work in the Vineyard. Christ Student Udofia in London does the same. I want to send you little ones to go and serve in a wonderful way, throughout the whole world.

LOVE ACCOMPLISHES MUCH:

(Hebrew 13:1)

All the old prophets of God like our Father Abraham are here. All fishes in Water, animals in the bush, are complete here. This is why you are told not to kill any creature created by God. This knowledge has not yet come to the world.

This is why God our Father called us, to show and teach us about the New Kingdom of God. We have to do on earth as it is done in heaven. There is no man nor woman. Since you have been baptised, and have on Christ, you are all one. All that obtains here is love.

Do not call people into Brotherhood of the Cross and Star fold, you are only told to continue in loving one another. Let brotherly love continue. Whatever good thing you can do

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continue doing it. Our Lord Jesus the Christ advised that we continue in loving one another He is the Lord of Lords, He is all and in all.

My children, I always expect to see you come out to the Prayer - stand to pray, and involve yourselves in all the activities such as: Reading the Bible during services, giving testimonies. But, you do not do these things. You are very lucky sets. I have told you, I want virgins your parents were not as lucky as you are".

MOST OF YOU ARE AMONG THE ONE-FORTY-FOUR-THOUSAND

WEEK 1:

Acts 3: 20

I have brought glad tidings. The convenant which God made with Abraham has come to manifestation. When you get home read again Acts 3: 25. Tell your parents that you are not the children of the world, flesh or perdition, but children of God. There is no other fortune you could come across now, than the Kingdom of God which you have inherited.

You are prophet's children. There is no other person to teach you to know the Father except your parents. Most children dream dreams and see visions. No one teaches you these. You do these because you are among the one forty-four Thousand that will inherit the Kingdom of God. It is through you that your parents have salvation.

WEEK 2: CHILDREN OF PROMISE

It is now your place to live a life worthy of praise. You start at infancy to know God. All children here now and those to come are children of God. That is why your parents are told not to beat you. It is also your duty to obey and serve your parents and God.

Our Lord Jesus Christ said that the Kingdom of God is for children. Do you not see this statement now fulfilled?
Zacharias and Elizabeth were true servants of God, you will remember. (Luke 1:5-15).
Their son John the Baptist, because he was a child of promise, did great works, He was also the child of a prophet. (Luke 1:26-33) - Our Lord Jesus Christ also was a child of promise. What was done to the Isrealites has to be done to the Gentiles.

WEEK 3. YOUR GREAT TASK IS TO CHANGE YOUR PARENTS

Most of you are great visioners, but refuse to reveal what you see. Through most of you God restores health to the sick when you pray, God does this, because you are God's children. You have a very great task at hand. This task is to change your parents and bring them to God.

I give you a story to illustrate things of heaven with those of the world.

There was a Bishop who could preach very well. But, he was a great sinner. He had a child. He thought whenever he stole, no one would see him. Beople respected and liked him. As he did not steal where he believed people and even God saw him. He read the Bible from Genesis to Revelation but failed to see where it was written, "Do not steal. He started stealing from his youth. As he was the sole preacher, no other person had preached to him not to steal.

One day, he went to steal in the Company of his little son. This time, he was stealing cassava. The man kept the child at a point to be on the watch, so that he could notify him when someone came along.

The child went near as the father was stealing the cassva, and told him that some one was looking at him. The Bishop ran out and asked the boy to show him the direction where the person was. The Bishop looked around and saw no one. He went back to dig more cassva, and even asked the boy to hlep dig quickly.

As they were digging the boy got up and told the father that somebody was looking at them. The Father insisted on seeing where that fellow was, to be able to look at them. It was then that the boy told the father that God was watching them. The Bishop confessed that he did not know that God was watching and seeing him all the time he was stealing right from his youth.

He told the son that from that moment he had to stop stealing. He was convinced that God is the only Supreme Being who sees in secret. They left all the cassava behind and went home. The Bishop was saved by his son, who told him not to steal as God had seen him.

Most of you are children of the ordained ones. This is why you think that you cannot tell your parents the evil they commit, like fornicating and telling lies.

The main reason why you were send to this Kingdom is for you to convert your parents. It is now your place to bring your parents nearer to God. With the spirit of God in you, always pray for the entire world to behave well. Try to bring up God's work. Forget about the number of ordained ones you see, for, the field is wide, but the reapers are few.

"God sees every body, you are the children of promise. So, there is no stumbling bleck to stop you from practising the word of God. Some of you do not attend the Sabbath Meetings regularly. Stop such habits. Show good example to others. Attend Sabbath Meetings regularly. Show obedience to your Sabbath Teachers/Mothers, Parents and all your elders.

Put your problems before God in Prayers. What the world disregards, is of great importance to God. The children Fellow-ships is the greatest of all Fellowships. Truly, there is power and life here (I want the house to be in reverence, for the Holy spirit is doing its work. You must ask

yourself why, if you fail to feel the impact of today's blessings).

The Children are like the mustard seed, so minute but when planted and nourished, they become large and many. I enjoin all children to be obedient, humble, God - fearing and pure. The spirit of God in you will lead you to perform wonderful works.

WEEK 5: SANCTIFY YOURSELF FOR GOD'S WORK

(Matt. 6:33)

"This is the time for spiritual food which will lead you to eternal life. We are looking for the one-hundred and forty-four thousand, and our hopes are on you, because our parents have failed us. I should like you to pray to the Father to give this required number and to change the entire world. You are witnesses that what God likes, man hates that, but what God hates, man admires that.

If John the Baptist did not give himself to God, we would not have seen these great works. If our Lord Jesus Christ did not surrender Himself to God, we would not have witnessed this salvation.

Ask not for material things like wealth, knowledge etc. Your fore-fathers asked for these things, but what did they gain? You are asked to seek for, You are asked to seek for the Holy Spirit. Ask for the Holy Spirit to direct you in all that you do.

ILLUSTRATIVE STORY:

'Once upon a time, there lived a King, who had two sons. He was an idol worshipper. He told his sons that he would share his domain and wealth to them if they would worship his idols with him. The first son accepted this offer and received much wealth.

The second son refused the father's offer. He said he could not worship a man-made god. He said he would only worship and serve the real God.

This second son left the father's offer. He remained in a distant place and started preaching the word of God. He tried to be upright trusting in God.

After some time, a letter was sent from his home to him reporting the death of his father. He refused to go home, because he believed that his God was with him. A second letter was sent. He refused going, saying that God was his father and he would lack nothing.

You have more opportunities to serve God than your parents, you are free from all the problems your parents have. For instance, you do not have to worry about food, houses, clothings for others. In this way, you are free to serve God.

God's children are born. It is not wise to think that you can serve God only when you are old. You are all precious to God. One Hundred and Forty-Four Thousand are required. You children stand a better chance of being among this number

You must be well-mannered so as to receive God's blessings. No disrespectful child has ever received God's blessings.

THIRD TERM

WEEK 1: LOVE THE HOLY SPIRIT (2 nd Corinthians 3:17)

Those who love the world do not love God; therefore do not love wordly things. Worldly things come from the flesh and not the Father. Those who love the Father have eternal life.
