Have mercy on them all most merciful Jesus and draw them to Thy Sacred Heart.

Be Thou King O Lord not only of the faithful who have never forsaken Thee, but als also of the prodigal children who have aboubded Thee. Grant that they die may quickly return to their Father Father's house lest they die of wratchedness and hunger. Be Thou King of all those who are deceived. by erroneous opinions or whom discord keeps elecf and call them back to the habbour of truth and unity of faith so that soon they may be one flock and one Shapherd. - . Frayer by four (4) members.
- . Washing the cooule's feet and anointment, while the Congre-gation sings the song (Amayom ndisanga ye Ami, suhore idem ...)
- At the end of anointment, the Spiritual Songs for blessing the couple continue: "Akamba Doctor" "Akaa Etubom Ekong"
- Frayer by the Officiating Brother.

- 9. Feast citations: Jahn 6:51; 1
 1st Cor. 10: 16 17. The Holy
 Sacrament is served to the couple
 while Choir continue to sing
 until the Sacrament is ever.
